Antique Assam Tea Farm 日月老茶廠

Yuchi, Nantou

A restored Japanese-era Assam tea factory — the historic anchor of Sun Moon Lake black tea.

Hugosum Black Tea Garden 和菓森林

Yuchi, Nantou

A black-tea garden built for visitors — a hands-on look at how the leaf becomes red tea.

Liao Township Black Tea Story Museum 廖鄉長紅茶故事館

Yuchi, Nantou

A black-tea story museum tracing the region's red-tea revival.

HOHOCHA (Taiwan Tea Sun Moon Lake Black Tea Factory) 喝喝茶（台灣香日月潭紅茶廠）

Yuchi, Nantou

Finish at a working black-tea factory for the full leaf-to-cup picture.

- Wild mountain (Shan Cha) black tea
