The route

1 Xiaoyin Tea House 小隱茶庵

Zhongzheng, Taipei

Reserve ahead — this is a quiet, booking-based tea room, so confirm availability before you go.

2 Eighty-Eightea Rinbansyo 八拾捌茶輪番所

Wanhua, Taipei

Pair a single-origin tea with seasonal wagashi in the restored temple lodge.

3 Shi Jian Tea 十間茶屋

Xinyi, Taipei

Finish the afternoon with gongfu-style tea or a bottled cold brew at this design-forward Xinyi tea bar.

WHAT TO DRINK

- Aged and roasted Taiwanese oolong
- Single-origin high mountain oolong
- Cold-brew oolong and bottled tea

BEFORE YOU GO

- Xiaoyin is reservation-based and deliberately quiet — book ahead and arrive unhurried.
- The three stops sit across central Taipei; verify each venue's current opening status on its official source before planning your timing.
- Carry some cash alongside cards — smaller tea houses don't always take every payment method.

Venue details and opening status can change. This card is editorial planning context — always verify a venue's current details on its official source before visiting.
